INFORMATION ALERT

This alert is to inform you that SINGAPORE, on Thursday afternoon of 30 April 2009, has raised the Swine Flu alert status from YELLOW to **ORANGE**. There is currently no human case in Singapore.

According to the Singapore Health Ministry, the heightened alert is to ensure that the island "is prepared at all front to delay its spread to Singapore for as long as possible". The WHO continues to maintain its pandemic phase at level 5.

Companies are now advised to implement the precautionary measures of ALERT **ORANGE** that were sent to you in Issue 4, dated 30 April 2009.
