Mr Thomas Lee will join *RafflesHospital* as General Manager in July 2007. Mr Lee has more than 20 years of experience in executive-level healthcare management, both in the United States and Asia.

- Mr Lee has been the Chief Executive Officer at Mount Alvernia Hospital since 2003, where he directed the operations and strategic development of the 303-bed facility.
- From 1996 to 2002, he was with Vista Healthcare Asia as Senior Vice President in Singapore, and subsequently provided leadership and direction for Vista's Philippine operations
- From 1990 to 1996, Mr Lee was the Chief Executive Officer of two private hospitals in Singapore, the East Shore Hospital and Mount Elizabeth Hospital.
- Prior to that, Mr Lee worked in the United States and India.
