RafflesMedicalGroup Opens New Medical Centre in Osaka, Japan

7 September 2015 – *RafflesMedicalGroup* (**Group**), a leading integrated private healthcare provider in Singapore and the region, is opening a medical centre at Herbis Osaka, 4th Floor, 2-5-25 Umeda, Kita-ku in Osaka City, Japan. This marks the Group's first entry into operating clinical facilities in Japan. Osaka is the second largest city in Japan, and is a regional gateway city with increasing business and tourism linkages with Korea and China.

Conveniently located in the prime central business district at the downtown Osaka/Umeda station, *RafflesMedical Osaka* is a 5,400-square feet facility that offers family medicine, travel medicine, dermatology and aesthetics, traditional Chinese medicine, and health screening services to local Japanese and expatriate patients as well as international tourists visiting Osaka. There is a sizeable working population in the vicinity and many Japanese visit the area for shopping, leisure and recreational purposes. Herbis Osaka, where the clinic is located, has retail, office and hotel components, with the Ritz Carlton Osaka located in the same building. *RafflesMedical Osaka*'s excellent location and its breadth of medical services would enable it to provide comprehensive and integrated medical services to its patients and clients. In addition, the clinic is staffed with both Japanese and foreign physicians as well as professionals who can provide multi-lingual support for foreigners.

RafflesMedical Osaka will be operated by the Group's subsidiary, RafflesJapaneseClinic, in collaboration with its joint venture Japanese partner Socion Healthcare Management Ltd. Started in 2002, RafflesJapaneseClinic caters to the Japanese community living in Singapore, and has expanded its business steadily, with three clinics located at RafflesHospital, Liang Court and Wheelock Place, and a clinic in Shanghai. Leveraging on this experience and the Group's expertise with international patients, RafflesJapaneseClinic is well-poised to take its business into Japan.

Commenting on this development, Dr Prem Kumar Nair, Chief Corporate Officer of *RafflesMedicalGroup* said: "We see this as an opportunity to extend the *Raffles* brand of care to the Japanese market. Japan is an advanced healthcare economy and we are excited at the prospect of starting operations there."
