RafflesHospital Records Profit Growth of 168 Per Cent as **RafflesMedicalGroup** Achieves Strong 2nd Quarter 2005 Results

RafflesMedicalGroup continues its strong 2005 performance, as hospital services continue to drive the Group's revenue growth.

RafflesHospital's Profit After Tax and Minority Interest (PATMI) surged by **168**% over the same period last year.

Boosted by an increase in both local and foreign patient visits, hospital services revenue grew by *31.6*% this quarter, compared to the same period last year.

As a Group, revenue grew by **9.5%**, from **\$25.3 million** in Q2 2004 to **\$27.7 million** in Q2 2005.

The Group's PATMI grew by **21.2%**, from **\$2.3 million** in Q2 2004 to **\$2.7 million** in Q2 2005.

To serve our patients better, we have made further investments in advanced medical technology.

Raffles Hospital recently acquired the revolutionary 64-Slice CT Scanner which allows for ultra fast imaging of the heart, coronary arteries, head, colon and lung without the need for invasive procedures such as an angiogram.

The Healthcare Services division has opened five new clinics, out of seven planned for 2005, maintaining *RafflesMedical* clinics as the largest group of Family Medicine clinics in Singapore today.

With a buoyant economic outlook in Singapore and the region, the Directors expect the Group to perform better in the second half of 2005.
