RafflesMedicalGroup Buoys the Singapore-Hong Kong Air Travel Bubble With the Launch of First App-based COVID-19 Test Booking

- Consumers can pre-book, pay and receive COVID-19 test results with Raffles Connect
- Pre-book round trip departure tests in Singapore and Hong Kong

12 November 2020, Singapore – As Singapore prepares to re-start travel and reopen borders with the world's first reciprocal Air Travel Bubble (ATB) with the first Singapore-Hong Kong bubble flight on 22 November, *RafflesMedicalGroup* (the Group) announced today the first seamless app-based booking, payment and receipt of COVID-19 polymerase chain reaction (PCR) tests in Singapore.

Through the Group's proprietary integrated healthcare platform <u>Raffles Connect</u>, travellers will be able to book their COVID-19 PCR tests in advance, ahead of their travel plans. Currently available for travellers in Singapore, individuals are able to pre-book their appointments for the COVID-19 PCR tests and head to any of the 36 *RafflesMedical* clinics in the Group's extensive network islandwide for the test. Payment for the tests and receipt of individual test results will all be available on the same platform in-app; results for the COVID-19 PCR tests will be available within 24 - 36 hours of administration of the test. Presently travellers will continue to receive the physical copy of their test results from the respective clinics as aligned with the guidelines from the relevant authorities.

Travellers also benefit from a full continuum of existing health services in-app, such as telemedicine services leveraging video consultations with a Raffles doctor, medical appointment booking and purchase of health supplements and services. The launch of this service underscores the Group's continual commitment to the fight against COVID-19, whilst keeping Singaporeans and residents safe and tackling the evolving challenges of COVID-19. This is the culmination of the deep medical expertise and experience of Singapore's largest home grown private healthcare provider.



By simply using our Raffles Connect mobile app, travellers will have access to a continuum of healthcare offerings including the ability to book, pay and receive results of the COVID-19 polymerase chain reaction (PCR) tests. This further enhances and complements our existing digital health offering through Raffles Connect, empowering travellers to be prepared to re-engage in travel safely."

App-based booking, payment and receipt of COVID-19 PCR tests

Using the Raffles Connect app, travellers will be able to conveniently make a booking for COVID-19 PCR tests, payment as well as receive the results of the test. Travellers simply have to follow the following steps:

- 1. Register or sign-in to the Raffles Connect app.
- 2. Click on the "COVID-19 Test" category in the main app interface.
- Click on the "Buy Now" purchase button for COVID-19 PCR test and submit a Health Declaration Form.
- 4. Select a Raffles Medical clinic of choice and an appointment slot will be offered to you closest to your departure date.
- 5. Submit flight details of the travel itinerary.
- 6. Choose a mode of payment in-app.
- 7. Receive reminders of the appointment through the app and within 24-36 hours of administration the test, receive test results in-app and from the clinic.

This service is currently available primarily to outbound travellers from Singapore, and at *RafflesMedical* clinics in two locations in <u>Hong Kong</u> – Central and Tsim Sha Tsui. As more reciprocal travel arrangements are established, the Group has the capability to scale this offering to other cities and cater for more travellers. RMG will be proactively ramping up testing capabilities and optimising operations in relation to the ATB ahead of the first passenger flight to Hong Kong on 22 November as well as in preparation to cater for the demand for voluntary testing from 1 December.

The Group also continues to be heavily involved in national projects involving different forms of testing for COVID-19 including rapid Antigen testing and serology tests. This could see the Group offering more types of tests for consumers in collaboration with the relevant authorities and guidelines in market.
