# **Maternity** Guide

This guide is specially prepared to provide you with essential information for your delivery in Raffles Hospital and for the care of your newborn baby.

We are 'Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative' certified

#### **Admission Checklist**

#### **Elective Admission for Delivery**

On the scheduled date of admission, please proceed to our Business Centre at Level 8, from Monday to Friday, 8.00am – 5.30pm for registration. After office hours, please proceed to our Business Centre at Level 10 for registration.

#### Admission for Emergency Delivery

In the event of emergency delivery, or when you feel that birth is imminent, please call **6311 1500** and proceed directly to our Labour Ward at Level 8.

#### Registration for Admission

Please bring the following documents for registration:

- Letter of Admission (given to you at the clinic)
- Identity Card / FIN Card / Passport of both patient and spouse
- Identity Card of the Medisave Account Holder
- Letter of Guaranty (LOG) if applicable

#### Deposit

- Deposit for delivery will be collected upon admission (If you have signed up for a hospital package, full payment of the package price will be required upon admission)
- Payment may be made in cash, NETS or credit card

### What to Bring for your Stay

Pack your bag two weeks in advance and prepare for a hospital stay of about two days for normal delivery and three days for Caesarean section:



#### For mother

- Two Breastfeeding brassieres
- A warm cardigan
- Slippers
- Extra panties and sanitary pads
- Breast pump set

#### For baby

- · Baby mittens & booties
- Baby vest and wrapping blanket for the day of discharge

#### Items provided by the Hospital

#### For mother

- Basic toiletries pack, which includes shampoo & bath foam, comb, face towel, toothbrush and toothpaste
- Disposable bedroom slippers for Single and Deluxe Rooms and Suites
- Breast pump is available upon request at no extra charge. Other accessories such as funnel and bottle, are chargeable
- Breastfeeding gowns during hospital stay

#### For baby

(Package items – for first pack only, subsequent packs will be chargeable)

- Disposable diapers
- Baby wet wipes
- Baby vest and swaddle during hospital stay

# Post Delivery Services

#### Postnatal / Confinement Care

Our nurses will take care of you in the postnatal ward and teach you on breastfeeding and how to care for your baby. You will usually be discharged after a two to threeday stay. If you wish to stay longer for your confinement and need assistance with breastfeeding, please discuss with our Ward Manager.

Our Hospital provides a confinement menu. Please ask our friendly ward staff upon admission.

#### ParentCraft / Lactation Services

As new mums and dads, you may be anxious about caring for your newborn. At Raffles, daily ParentCraft classes are available during your maternity stay for both your spouse and yourself.

During this informative session, our lactation consultant will provide you with tips on caring for your newborn and demonstrate how you can bathe and breastfeed your baby successfully. Following your discharge, you will be entitled to one complimentary consultation service.

The sessions are useful not only for first-time parents, but can also serve as an excellent refresher course for experienced parents.

Should you have any queries about caring for your newborn following your discharge, you are welcome to call our nursery at **6311 1517**.

#### Breastfeeding Consultation

Breastfeeding consultation is available daily during office hours at a chargeable price. One complimentary consultation will be given after discharge.

Should you need any breastfeeding consultation, kindly contact us at **6311 1516** / **7**.

#### Metabolic Screening and Hearing Test

Metabolic Screening and Hearing Test for newborns are available during your baby's stay in the nursery. These tests are performed 24 hours after birth.

#### Jaundice Screening

Screening for jaundice is provided for newborns using bilirubin analyser. It involves placing a simple scanning device lightly over the baby's forehead. It is painless and does not require a blood test via heel prick.

A first scan will be done during your baby's stay with us in the nursery if he / she appears to be jaundiced. Otherwise, the screening scan will be done during your baby's first week visit at the Raffles Children Centre.

## Infant Massage Class

This course is suitable for parents of baby aged from one to twelve months. Parents need to bring along their babies for the course. For more information, please contact us at **63111516** / **7**.

#### **Baby Footprints Services**
