RafflesMedicalGroup Marks 50 Years of Care with S\$5 Million Commitment to Advance Healthcare, Strengthen Communities, and Award 50 Scholarships Over the Next Five Years

Singapore, 1 August 2026 – **RafflesMedicalGroup (RMG or the Group)** today announced a five-year S\$5 million commitment to increase access to healthcare and education, advance healthy longevity research and support vulnerable communities. The Group will also award 50 scholarships over the next five years for students from Singapore and the region pursuing healthcare-related studies.

The announcements were made at the Group's 50th Anniversary Dinner, graced by Guest of Honour, Mr Tharman Shanmugaratnam, President of the Republic of Singapore. Mr Ong Ye Kung, Minister for Health and Coordinating Minister for Social Policies, also attended the dinner.

Extending Care to Communities

The pledge of S\$5 million over five years will focus on four priority areas: increasing access to healthcare, supporting education, advancing healthy longevity research, and uplifting vulnerable communities. Together, these initiatives reflect the Group's values of Compassion and Commitment and reinforce its dedication to making a meaningful contribution to the communities it serves.

One of the first initiatives under the commitment is a two-year partnership with Children's Aid Limited (CAL), formerly known as Children's Aid Society. Over the next two years, RMG will partner CAL to make specialised care more accessible to children and youths who have experienced adverse life circumstances and are under the residential care of Melrose Home, with therapeutic and counselling services under Melrose Care, to support healing, healthy development and long-term well-being. RMG's support will include funding a senior on-site psychologist, providing workshops on mental wellness and sleep hygiene, and offering vaccinations and medical consultations and help ensure that children and youths receive consistent, high-quality care. This commitment will continue as CAL embarks on its next chapter with Melrose Village.

Nurturing the Next Generation of Healthcare Talent

The Group will also award 50 scholarships over the next five years for students from Singapore and the region pursuing healthcare-related studies. Through the programme, RMG aims to develop healthcare talent across the cities in which it operates and nurture the next generation of professionals and leaders who will shape the future of healthcare. Since 2012, RMG has provided 51 scholarships to Singaporeans and others in the region.

Commemorating Five Decades of Care

A commemorative book, "[Moments that Matter, Fifty Years of Care](#)" was launched at the celebratory dinner. Through the lens of 50 individuals whose dedication and vision have helped chart the Group's journey, the book chronicles the Group's five-decade journey from a two-clinic practice in 1976 to its integrated network of four hospitals and more than 100 clinics across 12 cities in five countries today.

The anniversary celebration follows another significant milestone for the Group, which crossed 50 million patient visits in July 2026. The figure reflects cumulative patient visits across RMG's integrated healthcare network over the past five decades and the trust placed in the Group by generations of patients and their families.

Over the past 50 years, RMG has continually expanded its continuum of services to meet the changing healthcare needs of patients. From primary and specialist care to hospital services, diagnostics, dental services, insurance and corporate healthcare, the Group delivers coordinated, team-based and patient-centred care across every stage of life.

As it enters its next chapter, RMG will build on five decades of care by investing in people, advancing preventive care and healthy longevity, and extending its contribution to the communities it serves.
